1. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

2. Introduction of New Officers

Chief Crowell introduced Officer Mathew Applebee and Officer Julia Quinlan. The Police Committee welcomed the new officers and discussed their experience during field training.

3. Minutes

A motion was made by Member McGrew and seconded by Member Champagne to approve the minutes of April 10, 2019. Member Green abstained. The motion passed unanimously.

Member Abbott reported that the Minoa Field Days and Memorial Day Parade events are coming up.

Member Champagne requested more police patrols near the Minoa pole barn. Member Champagne reported several cases of vandalism in the pole barn despite increased security measures.

Discussion ensued regarding enforcement of trespassing violations and an increase in trespassing in local parks after dark.

Member Champagne reported speeding complaints in Minoa Farms. Discussion ensued regarding the installation of more speed limit signs and an increase in patrols.

Member McGrew discussed traffic enforcement issues on Post Road. Discussion ensued regarding an increase in signage on Post Road.

The committee discussed how speeding in the Villages could be addressed.

6. Chiefs Report

- Chief Crowell reported that the 2018 Annual Report has been released and distributed.
- Chief Crowell stated that department in-service training has been going well.
- Chief Crowell reported that the strategic plan is progressing.
- Chief Crowell stated that the current Citizen Police Academy is graduating, and new academy will take place in the fall.
- Chief Crowell gave an update on the crisis intervention training.
- Chief Crowell stated that the department has hired a new officer and has 3 recruits in the current academy.
- Chief Crowell stated that the Memorial Day Parade safety plans have been prepared and completed.
- Chief Crowell stated that the SIRO positions in the school districts have been filled.
- Chief Crowell stated that he attended the District Attorney's annual luncheon and discussed the challenges that the department is facing due to recent criminal justice reform.

The committee discussed the departments drone program and drone regulations.
