Councilor Nesci suggested that the By-Laws be reviewed annually. The committee agreed to review the By-Laws at the August 12 meeting.

Councilor Nicholson also attended the PBA dinner and commented positively on the event. He announced that the public engagement process and the Town of Manlius Facility Study Group information would be released that evening and encouraged

committee members to participate if possible.

Department Report

Chief Cassalia reported that one recruit is graduating from the academy and three additional recruits are projected to graduate in October and begin field training. He also advised that a new transfer candidate has been selected and will take the oath on May 18.

Chief Cassalia reviewed the annual report and advised the committee regarding the department's state accreditation process. The onsite accreditation review is scheduled for July 28–30. He also spoke about several community events the department has been involved in.

Chief Cassalia announced that the department's Open House will be held on May 16 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The department will also be collecting donations for local food pantries during the event.
