Set Date – Public Hearing - Local Law 2018-1 - Posting of Weight Restrictions of 10 Tons on Vehicles Using Pierson Rd and George Taylor Road.

Supervisor Theobald gave a brief overview of proposed local law 2018-1.

Councilor Marzola asked what vehicles would qualify for the 10-ton weight restriction? Highway Superintendent Cushing stated that six wheelers would be over the weight limit and any local delivery trucks would be exempt.

Discussion ensued regarding the trucks that would be prohibited from using the roads.

Councilor Green made a motion, seconded by Councilor Rossetti, to set a date for a public hearing on July 25, 2018, at 6:35 PM in the matter of Local Law 2018-1 Posting of Weight Restrictions of 10 Tons on Vehicles Using Pierson Rd and George Taylor Road.

A) Highway Superintendent

Highway Superintendent Cushing stated that Windstream has decided not to proceed with the proposed highway permit to install two structures to enhance the wireless internet in the Enders Road and Glen Eagle neighborhood area. Windstream has contacted National Grid to request permission to install devices to enhance wireless internet on existing telephone poles.

D) Town Clerk

Town Clerk Weber stated that Supervisor Theobald has received a request from Cazenovia Area Community Development Association to send a letter of support for a Farm Land Grant Protection Grant for the parcels located on Peck Hill Road (tax parcel 116.-01-01.0 (80.76 acres) and 116.-01-24.0 (0.92 acres). Town Clerk Weber stated that the request was for the same application that was supported by the town and submitted in June 2016.

Councilor Bollinger made a motion, seconded by Councilor Green to authorize the Supervisor to sign a letter of support for a Farm Land Grant Protection Grant for the parcels located on Peck Hill Road (tax parcel 116.-01-01.0 (80.76 acres) and 116.-01-24.0 (0.92 acres).

E) Police Chief

Chief Crowell stated that the 4th of July celebrations in the Village of Manlius went well.

Chief Crowell gave a status update on the three new police officers that will be sworn in on August 8th.

F) Town Board

Potential Salt Springs Water District

Doug Miller, Engineer for the Town, gave an update on the continued discussions with the Town of Sullivan for a potential Salt Springs Water District. Town Engineer Miller stated that the Town of Manlius is reviewing potential cost-sharing scenarios.

Councilor Rossetti asked if the Town of Manlius had heard anything further from the town of Sullivan? Councilor Rossetti stated that after the last discussion with the Town of Sullivan he was of the belief that the Town of Sullivan was heading in a different

direction. Supervisor Theobald stated that there were still some issues that need to be resolved.

Councilor Marzola asked if grant money was still an option. Supervisor Theobald stated that grant money may still be available.

Deer Management Committee

Councilor Green stated the deer committee held a very productive meeting this week. Councilor Green stated that several local representatives were present, and the committee has recommended the town enter into an intermunicipal agreement with the Village of Fayetteville for a deer management program.

Supervisor Theobald stated that the Town of Manlius will benefit from working with a municipality who has already implemented a successful deer management program. Supervisor Theobald stated that the potential for the Town of Manlius to work with the Village of Fayetteville for deer management is a great shared services project.

Councilor Green stated that the Town of Manlius Recreation Department will be presenting “Legally Blonde the Musical” on July 19, 20 & 21.

Councilor Rossetti gave an update on the SIRO (School Information Resource Officer) contract negotiations. Councilor Rossetti stated that he will be meeting with the East Syracuse Minoa School District and the Fayetteville Manlius School District.

G) Supervisor – No New Business

There being no further business to come before the Board, upon motion duly made by Councilor Rossetti and seconded by Councilor Green the Board voted unanimously to adjourn regular session at 6:51 PM.
