1. The meeting was called to order at 5:03 p.m.

2. **Minutes**

- Compliance with the Raise the Age Legislation is going well.

Member Loeffler added that the 3rd School Information Resource Officer (SIRO) is doing well. Chief Crowell stated that the department is one of the only departments with five total SIROs.

Member Duggleby stated that the Critical Response Committee drill was well organized.
